

Title	<a href="#">Speech bubbles</a>
Brief description of clip	The original Speech Bubbles idea is based on children presenting words in their own mother tongue to other children across Europe (the programmes were broadcast on local television). Equally words in a foreign language can be presented. Words can be chosen from any theme which is done as part of the language lesson.
Difficulty rating of production (easy/intermediate/complex)	easy to intermediate
Recommended CEFR level	A1+
Technical details	The presented words can be overlaid with text or speech bubbles graphics using free video editing software such as windows Movie Maker live.
Suggestions (preparation/pre and post activities)	If you are voicing the words using young learners you will need parental permission to film, you could use audio recordings only and add the audio track to images or objects. In essence you will be creating a video revision tool for language learners that could be shared with a partner school or younger classes. This is particularly useful for culturally specific vocabulary for example the word <i>bread</i> would produce many different sorts of bread.
