

Title:	Stop Motion
Brief description of clip	This clip was created by primary school students as a way of communicating what they had learned about the French Revolution.
Difficulty rating (easy/intermediate/complex)	Intermediate to complex
CEFR level	B1+
Technical details	This is not a rapid process and it is helpful to have dedicated technical support. You need to take time to plan using a storyboard and use post production techniques to get the desired result.
Suggestions (preparation/pre and post activities)	The primary school pupils were given a 30-min introduction to the fall of the Bastille in 1789. Full details of the project can be seen here. Stop motion projects give opportunities for group work where discussion and collaboration are important as there are many decisions to agree upon.
Ideas for application in different contexts	Making a video can be a useful way of showing what has been understood at the end of a learning unit.
