

Title	Student reflecting
Brief description of clip	The student is providing reflection on a group activity the students did in the classroom.
Difficulty rating of production (easy/intermediate/complex)	easy to intermediate
Recommended CEFR level	B1+
Technical details	After the lesson the teacher wrote out a series of questions in a PowerPoint presentation that he/she wants the students to consider. The students have then loaded the questions into Present.Me and recorded their answers to the questions. The resulting link can then be sent to the teacher.
Suggestions (preparation/pre and post activities)	To help students develop their independent learning skills and to become more autonomous, it can be a good idea to get the students to reflect on their performance when interacting with other students, when preparing a written piece etc. After the students have performed a certain activity, the teacher can provide questions that encourage the students to reflect on their performance. The students can then upload these questions into tools like Present.Me and then record their answers to the questions. The student can then share the link with their teacher or embed the recordings into a blog.
Ideas for application in different contexts	Present.Me is a versatile tool. It can be used to develop student's oral skills. For example students can upload PowerPoint presentations and then record their voice and webcam with just one button click. The resulting recording can then be shared with other students or teachers. Present.Me can also be used for a Flipped Classroom approach. Teachers can upload PowerPoint presentations and then record their presentations. It will include audio and webcam input. These recordings can then be shared online, uploaded onto YouTube or added to a blog, a virtual learning environment.
