brief description of clip	School presentations are a universal video format where students introduce their own school. They are useful outcomes for European cooperation and exchange. The core ideas have been developed within the DIVIS project: http://divisproject.eu
Difficulty rating of production (easy/intermediate/complex)	easy to intermediate
Recommended CEFR level	A2+
Technical details	The productions can range from simple slideshows to sophisticated video productions. Choose an approach which best fits your context and budget, from PowerPoint to more complex video production techniques.
Suggestions (preparation/pre and post activities)	Include specific vocabulary related to school in an authentic setting. Develop presentation skills in the foreign language, with different students contributing to the creation of the audio or video content. Use storyboarding techniques to develop a recording plan for video and involve others across the school to raising the visibility of language learning. A completed video can be useful for establishing links with a partner school or for helping new arrivals settle in.
