| Difficulty rating of production (easy/intermediate/complex) | Easy to intermediate |

| Technical details | Very simple production with a mobile phone and post-production using Movie Maker. |
| Suggestions (preparation/pre and post activities) | Having met examples of telephone language and practised key expressions, learners can script and capture a conversation using simple video techniques. They can plan the location and make the recordings of both halves of the conversation separately and then edit them together. A matching activity where the clips of all parts of the conversations are available and the students have to find the responses and edit them together could also be very engaging. The planning and discussions can all be done using the target language. |
| Ideas for application in different contexts | You could use your international partners and send them one sided phone call conversations, then ask them to make a video answering the questions. |
